 GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation)

→ European Union



Both laws aim to protect personal data, but they differ in scope, enforcement, and principles.

Regulatory Body	 Data Protection Board (to be formed) 	 Supervisory Authorities (EU-wide)
Enforcement Maturity	• Emerging	• Well-established
Grievance Handling	• Right to redressal	 Well-established
Global Recognition	 Yet to be recognized globally 	International benchmark







GDPR



- Consent
- Contractual necessity
- Legal obligation
- Vital interests
- Public task
- Legitimate interests

Under India's DPDP Act is simpler than the GDPR, legal basis for personal data can be processed based on centers around two key bases:

- Consent
- Legitimate use (specified by the law)

Covers Digitized Offline Data	✓ Yes	✓ Yes
Covers Offline (Non-Digital) Data	× No	✓ Yes





Rights of Data Subjects

DPDP

- Right to access
- Right to rectification
- Right to be forgotten
- Right to restrict processing
- Right to data portability
- Right to object

- Right to access
- Right to correction & erasure
- Right to grievance redressal
- Right to nominate



Enforcement & Penalties

GDPR Supervisory Authorities in each EU state. Fines up to €20 million or 4% of global turnover. Data Protection Board of India. Penalties up to ₹250 crore (~€28 million).










Applicability & Scope

GDPR DPDP

- Applies to EU data subjects.
- Extra-territorial scope for foreign entities processing EU data

- Applies to digital personal data of individuals in India
- Includes data collected online or digitized offline data
